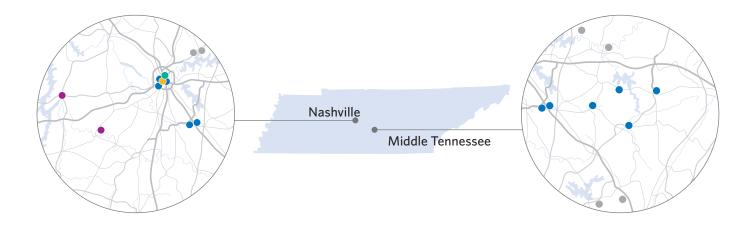

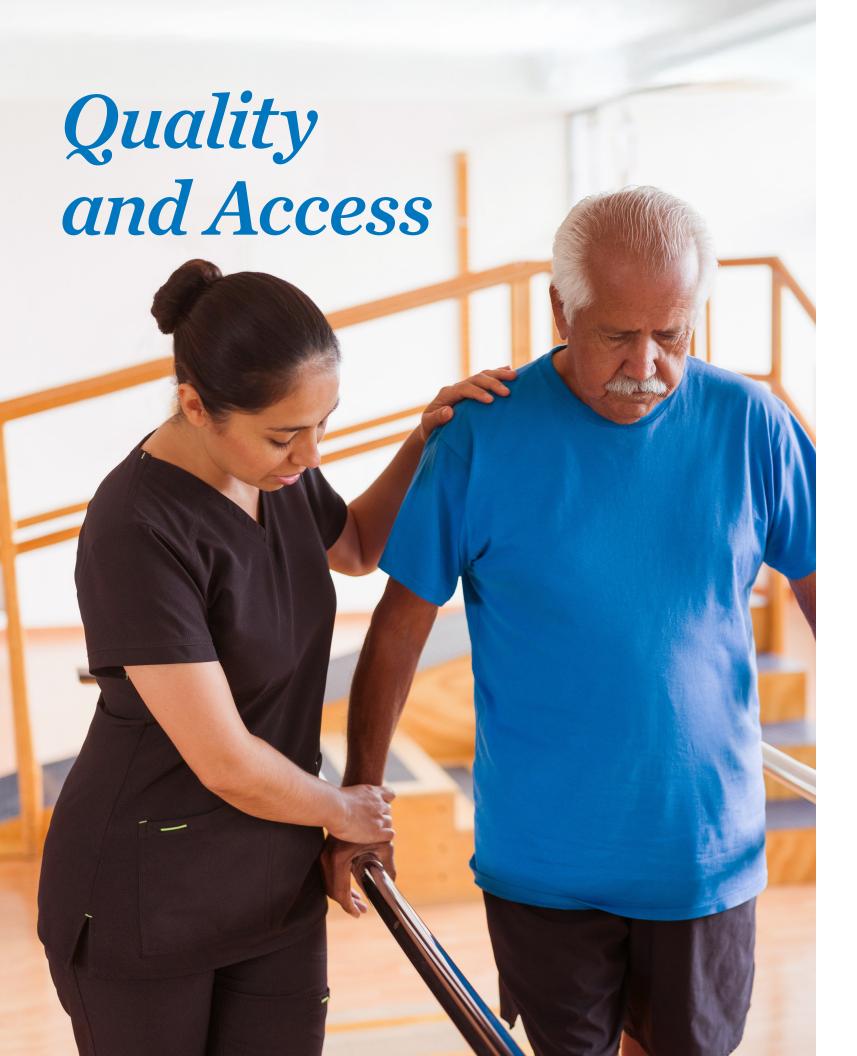

Specialized care for women

Heart disease remains the leading cause of death among women, yet symptoms often go undiagnosed or overlooked.

To address this critical issue, Ascension Saint Thomas Heart launched the Women's Heart Program — one of the first of its kind in Middle Tennessee.

Innovating maternal health: Blood pressure monitoring program

Ascension Saint Thomas Medical Partners UT OBGYN has partnered with The American Heart Association to launch a pioneering initiative that equips expectant mothers with at-home blood pressure kits alongside comprehensive educational resources. This program ensures that pregnant women have easy access to essential educational materials, blood pressure cuffs and personalized guidance for monitoring their health metrics.

Medical experts highlight that women experiencing high blood pressure during pregnancy are at increased risk of cardiovascular events in the subsequent decade. Conditions such as pre-eclampsia, gestational hypertension, preterm birth, stillbirth and fetal growth restriction are among the potential outcomes associated with elevated blood pressure during pregnancy.

Bringing families closer to their newborns

For parents with babies in the NICU, separation can be difficult. To strengthen the bond between families and their newborns, Ascension Saint Thomas Rutherford Hospital launched a secure, livestream camera system in the NICU.

The video cameras provide secure, livestream video access to a baby's progress from the comfort of any device — whether it's a phone, tablet or computer. The camera, which is positioned at the bedside, captures real-time footage of the baby's movements, allowing parents to feel more connected with their child as they watch them grow and develop.

This innovative service was made possible by the generous support of the Rutherford Foundation, which successfully led a fundraising effort to bring this advanced visual technology to Ascension Saint Thomas Rutherford Hospital's NICU.



SPOTLIGHT: Honoring every life with compassion

At Ascension Saint Thomas, our commitment to holistic, spiritual care extends to families experiencing pregnancy loss. During Pregnancy Loss Awareness Month in October, Ascension Saint Thomas Midtown Chaplain Chelsey Hedglin and the Diocese of Nashville coordinated a blessing for the newly installed monument at Calvary Cemetery in Nashville. Named for St. Gianna Molla, patroness of the unborn, the monument and the burials that will take place at the site demonstrate Ascension Saint Thomas' spiritual care department's commitment to honoring human dignity at the beginning of life. Approximately 80 families each year experience a fetal loss at our Midtown hospital, and Chelsey is the specialist chaplain who provides emotional and spiritual support to mothers, their families and the clinical associates that care for them.

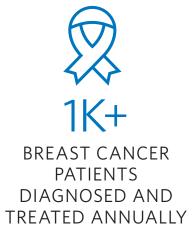

Tennessee Oncology and Ascension Saint Thomas launch community-based blood cancer treatment program

Tennessee Oncology and Ascension Saint Thomas have expanded their partnership to launch a new community-based oncology program that brings advanced CAR-T cell therapy to more patients across Middle Tennessee. This cutting-edge treatment, which modifies a patient's own immune cells to target and kill cancer, is now available through a coordinated care model between Tennessee Oncology and Ascension Saint Thomas. The initiative, which began in August 2024, aims to improve access to potentially lifesaving therapies for patients with aggressive or relapsed blood cancers.

SPOTLIGHT: Groundbreaking innovation in cancer treatment

Dr. John Lazar, chief of thoracic surgery at Ascension Saint Thomas Hospital, is using a groundbreaking technique to help detect lung cancer during surgery. He is the first surgeon in Middle Tennessee to use CYTALUX, a fluorescent drug that causes cancer cells to glow under a special near-infrared camera. This makes it easier for surgeons to spot lesions that might otherwise be difficult to detect.

Every day, our oncology teams are changing lives and advancing cancer care through innovation, expertise and Mission-driven service. Whether through lifesaving early detection, cutting-edge treatments or compassionate support, we remain committed to delivering the highest quality care with dignity and respect.

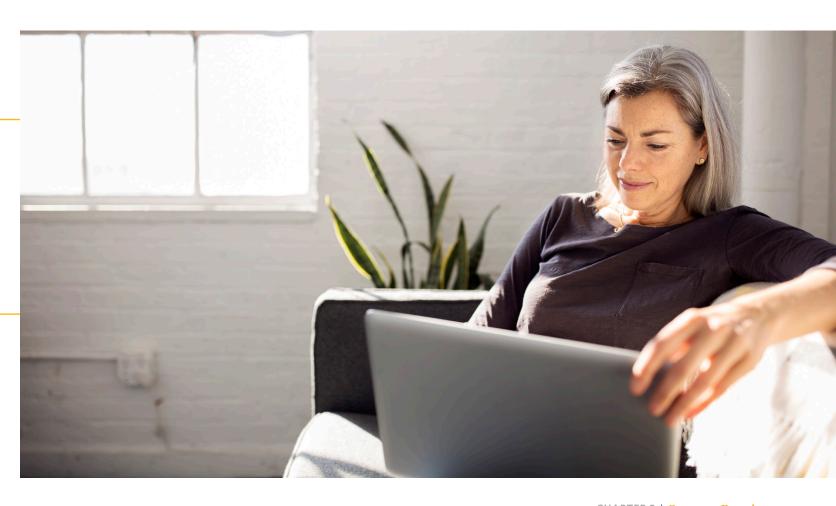

Ascension is introducing clinics after-hours support in select markets. This service gives patients the flexibility to reach someone regarding their schedule needs at any time, day or night. As well as page on-call providers.

Chat for scheduling

Ascension is making care more convenient by offering a voluntary web-based chat option. By offering this highly convenient channel, we ensure patients can reach us whenever they need to. For our associates, offering chat reduces call volume and allows them to handle multiple inquiries more efficiently.

Proactive outreach

Creating a better consumer experience means more than just delivering exceptional care — it's about ensuring the proper care happens at the right time. To achieve this, Ascension has introduced voluntary proactive outreach to support patients along their health journey. This outreach uses personalized messages via email and text to gently prompt patients to set follow-up appointments, take their medications, schedule annual wellness visits and complete screenings.

Reducing and communicating wait times

To improve patient satisfaction, we've taken a proactive approach to keeping patients informed and reassured about wait times. Regular updates that keep consumers informed create a calmer, more trusting environment where patients feel valued and respected. Additionally, we enhanced the arrival experience by training associates on the importance of first impressions to ensure patients feel welcomed and reassured from the moment they arrive.



Communicate the wait

The goal of this enhancement is to provide tools to better support our associates so they can provide even more clear, open and honest communication about wait times, helping set expectations for patients right from the start. By proactively informing patients about potential wait times, we aim to alleviate the anxiety that often comes with uncertainty about how long they will need to wait. Initially rolled out in the Emergency Department (ED), the initiative has now expanded to include medical practices.



The impact of "Communicate the Wait" has been positive. In FY25, patient feedback indicates notable improvements in wait time experience across care settings. The ED has seen a measurable rise in patient-reported satisfaction with wait time communication, while inpatient settings have also experienced a meaningful increase, in part due to improved communication beginning in the ED. Early results in medical practices also show encouraging trends, reinforcing the value of setting clear expectations.

As we continue refining and expanding this approach, we remain focused on enhancing the patient experience across all care settings.

Creating calming spaces

We are committed to creating clean, calming spaces that reflect our high standards of care and promote patient recovery and satisfaction.

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Lounges

Ascension Saint Thomas Hospital Midtown and Ascension Saint Thomas Rutherford Hospital are undergoing updates to create EMS lounges that provide a place of respite for emergency responders.

Ascension Saint Thomas Hospital West Emergency Department

A new design for the emergency department is under construction that will include thoughtful seating options in warm color palettes that offer our consumers comfort.



A focus on wayfinding

We're creating a seamless wayfinding experience that includes intuitive navigation, clear signage and maps, and strategic color coding. To enhance these physical elements, we will provide intuitive digital tools that offer essential information before and during visits. This evolution in wayfinding will benefit patients, their families and our associates alike.



Language services

Acknowledging the critical role language plays in healthcare access, we have significantly expanded our language services. Ascension Saint Thomas' interpreters, translators and partners are vital to fulfilling our Mission by ensuring that patients from diverse linguistic backgrounds, and those who are deaf or hard of hearing receive the care they deserve.

Additionally, Ascension Saint Thomas offers guidance and tools for serving individuals who are blind or visually impaired, including information accessibility, staff training and adaptive equipment and technology.

In 2024, we completed 142,192 audio translations for patients in our care and 42.068 video translations for patients in our care. This totals 1,904,590 minutes of translation services in 2024 to meet the needs of patients and provide them with care in their preferred language.

Our top languages in 2024 were Spanish (accounting for 88.7% of all translations), Arabic, Haitian Creole, Vietnamese and Swahili. We are expanding our language services to accommodate rare languages.

We are now providing translation services for ancient Mayan languages to support our growing diverse population in Middle Tennessee.

Breaking down communication barriers

Through our yearly Medical Mission at Home events, Ascension Saint Thomas provides free medical care to those with limited access and who are struggling in the communities we serve. Translation services with an interpreter are available in more than 30 languages, either over the phone or in-person. This enables our volunteers to more effectively communicate with our most at-risk populations to meet their healthcare needs during the event.



WHEN YOU LEAVE — **POST-CARE ADVANCEMENTS**

Exceptional care doesn't end when patients leave our facilities. We are committed to ensuring the post-care phase is just as comprehensive as the care provided on-site.

With real-time Net Promoter Score tracking, patients can provide immediate feedback, allowing us to promptly address concerns, make improvements and acknowledge positive experiences. Our focus on real-time recovery and ongoing communication ensures patients feel valued and supported after their visit.

Real-time listening

We've made real-time Net Promoter Score (NPS) listening and responsive actions a priority across all Ascension Saint Thomas care sites to ensure we're continuously improving the consumer experience

Service recovery

After each visit, patients receive a survey to share feedback on everything from scheduling to discharge. This input is available through an online dashboard, providing associates immediate access to positive feedback and giving leaders actionable insights for recognition, coaching, performance enhancements and quick problem-solving.

Real-time recovery

Real-time NPS provides instant feedback, allowing us to continuously monitor and improve satisfaction. This approach enables quick recovery and immediate adjustments. If a patient reports a concern, our team is immediately notified to address it — ensuring a quick response and a better care experience. This system ensures we address concerns promptly, showing our dedication to excellence and building patient loyalty.





The billing experience -

Ascension Saint Thomas is simplifying the billing experience by consolidating charges into a single, easy-tounderstand statement to make billing more transparent and reduce stress for patients and their families. Through the Ascension One app or at ascension.org, patients can view their balance, make a payment, check insurance coverage, set up payment plans and access financial assistance.

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CARING FOR OUR COMMUNITIES

Creating lasting change

At Ascension Saint Thomas, we are more than a healthcare provider — we are a partner in building healthier communities. Guided by our Mission to serve all, with special attention to those most in need, we work alongside residents, community leaders and local organizations to address the social, medical and spiritual needs of those we serve.

Caring for the social, spiritual and medical needs of others is central to our Mission. Good health starts beyond hospital walls — it starts with meeting people where they are, breaking down barriers and advocating for a more just and compassionate society.



Understanding and addressing community needs

To truly serve our communities, we must first listen. Every three years, we conduct Community Health Needs Assessments (CHNAs) to identify critical health priorities and guide our investments in community well-being.

Ascension Saint Thomas partners with residents and key community leaders to address the health priorities identified through the CHNA, focusing particularly on vulnerable populations.

The findings of the 2021 CHNA cycle have highlighted three key areas of need.

To gain a deeper understanding of the social factors affecting our patients, we have expanded our survey scope to include both outpatient and inpatient settings. As a result, we received over 155,000 self-reported patient survey responses, shedding light on critical issues such as housing instability, unequal access to healthcare and lack of education.



ENHANCING ACCESS TO CARE AND SUPPORT

Dispensary of Hope

For uninsured and low-income patients in Tennessee, access to essential medications can mean the difference between thriving and struggling with poor health. Through our partnership with Dispensary of Hope, we provide lifesaving medications at no cost to patients in need.

Founded in Middle Tennessee, Dispensary of Hope began as a local effort to redistribute unused medications to those in need. Over time, this mission grew into a national program, and today, Dispensary of Hope operates as a subsidiary of Ascension, working with pharmaceutical manufacturers to provide lifesaving medications to nonprofit pharmacies that distribute them at no cost to patients.

Community Health Workers

Community Health Workers (CHWs) play a crucial role in overcoming barriers that prevent patients from attending wellness visits, receiving vaccinations, and managing chronic conditions like hypertension and diabetes. They act as trusted connectors between the community and health/social services, expanding access to care and improving health outcomes. Research has shown that when integrated into communities through a coordinated care model, CHWs can lower healthcare costs, improve health outcomes and reduce health disparities.

These workers are a critical part of our care team. We are grateful for the support of TennCare and Tennessee Department of Health in supporting our organization in adding this workforce to support our patients.

Partnership success: mammogram screenings

Mammogram screenings

During Breast Cancer Awareness Month (October 2024), Ascension Saint Thomas partnered with Premier Radiology in Bellevue to offer free mammogram screenings to uninsured women. The initiative sought to eliminate financial and systemic barriers, ensuring all women, regardless of insurance status, could receive early screenings to detect potential health issues like breast cancer.

The program identified 1,567 women who could benefit from free mammograms, reaching over 200 individuals to schedule screenings during October. Information was provided in both English and Spanish to ensure accessibility for all.





HOW COMMUNITY INVESTMENT IS MAKING A DIFFERENCE

In FY24, Ascension Saint Thomas invested \$253,333 in 12 community-based organizations to improve access to care across Middle Tennessee.

- Second Harvest Food Bank of Middle Tennessee funded three mobile pantries in Cannon County and two in White County, providing fresh produce and pantry staples to 3,125 individuals facing hunger.
- **Interfaith Dental** provided oral health access and services for 3,722 individuals experiencing poverty.



Medical Mission at Home

We hosted Medical Mission at Home events in June 2024 and May 2025 to deliver free, high-quality care directly to those in need in Davidson and surrounding counties. In June, more than 550 volunteers gathered at the Nashville Fairgrounds to provide medical, dental, behavioral health and vision services to over 1,100 patients. More recently, in May, more than 860 individuals received care through the event.

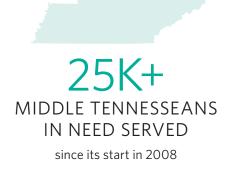
The events, which required no insurance or payment, reflects our organization's commitment to community service, with language interpreters available for assistance.

MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE MISUSE

Mental health: expanding access and support -

Addressing mental health requires a holistic, collaborative approach that brings together resources across various sectors. In FY24, integrated behavioral health and counseling services within primary care clinics ensured that more than 151,000 patients received screenings, counseling or treatment for depression — making mental health care more accessible at critical points of care.

Beyond clinical settings, Ascension Saint Thomas Emergency Medical Services (EMS) expanded mental health education, equipping first responders with essential training through 21 classes across 11 counties. These efforts help ensure that emergency responders can recognize and address mental health needs in the field.

By integrating mental health care into primary care, expanding education and fostering community support, these initiatives create a stronger, more connected network of care for individuals and families in need.



HOW COMMUNITY INVESTMENT IS MAKING A DIFFERENCE

In FY24, Ascension Saint Thomas invested \$167,000 in 12 community-based organizations across Middle Tennessee to expand access to essential services.

- AGAPE provided 397 Spanish-speaking counseling sessions, supporting 94 new clients and 18 continuing clients, ensuring culturally competent mental health care.
- Gilda's Club Middle Tennessee provided 298 professionally led support group sessions, licensed clinical staff responded to 2,095 individual resource requests via licensed clinical staff, and created 134 customized cancer support plans for new members.
- Nashville Rescue Mission assisted 74 individuals in completing the Life Recovery Program, a nationally recognized, intensive substance use disorder treatment program open to guests from all 50 states.

Healing from substance misuse

Access to lifesaving resources, education and recovery support is essential for individuals struggling with substance misuse. In response, Ascension Saint Thomas has taken steps to expand prevention and treatment efforts across Middle Tennessee.

A streamlined process provided free naloxone nasal spray, a lifesaving medication, through state and county programs, with 276 units distributed at facilities and 207 units through Ascension Rx Pharmacies during FY24. Early intervention remains a priority, with 12,647 individuals screened for alcohol misuse to identify and address substance use concerns before they escalate.

HOW COMMUNITY INVESTMENT IS MAKING A DIFFERENCE

In FY24, to further support recovery efforts, Ascension Saint Thomas invested \$40,000 in community-based organizations addressing substance misuse.

- The Next Door served 1,418 women in FY24, with an average 23-day residential treatment stay, including detox and recovery support.
- Women of Worth (WOW) helped 45 women transition from incarceration, with 43 securing full-time jobs and 13 gaining permanent housing.

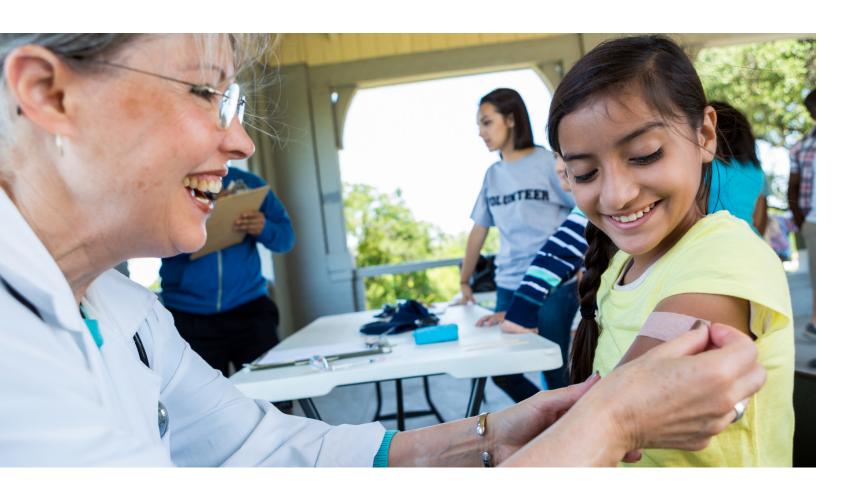
Service in the community: Nonprofit boards

Neighbors helping neighbors

Ascension Saint Thomas supports the work of local organizations whose efforts are vital to improving health and well-being within our communities. During FY24, we provided \$615,333 to 32 organizations that are addressing access to care, mental health and substance misuse in our communities, bringing comfort, nourishment and support to those in need. Through this program, associates continue to live out our Mission by making a direct and meaningful impact in the lives of others.



Year of service projects

Launched in April 2024, the Year of Service Projects program provides Ascension Saint Thomas associates with opportunities to actively support their communities through hands-on service. In its first year, volunteers participated in 17 events, dedicating their time and talents to initiatives that bring comfort, nourishment and support to those in need.

Blankets for children

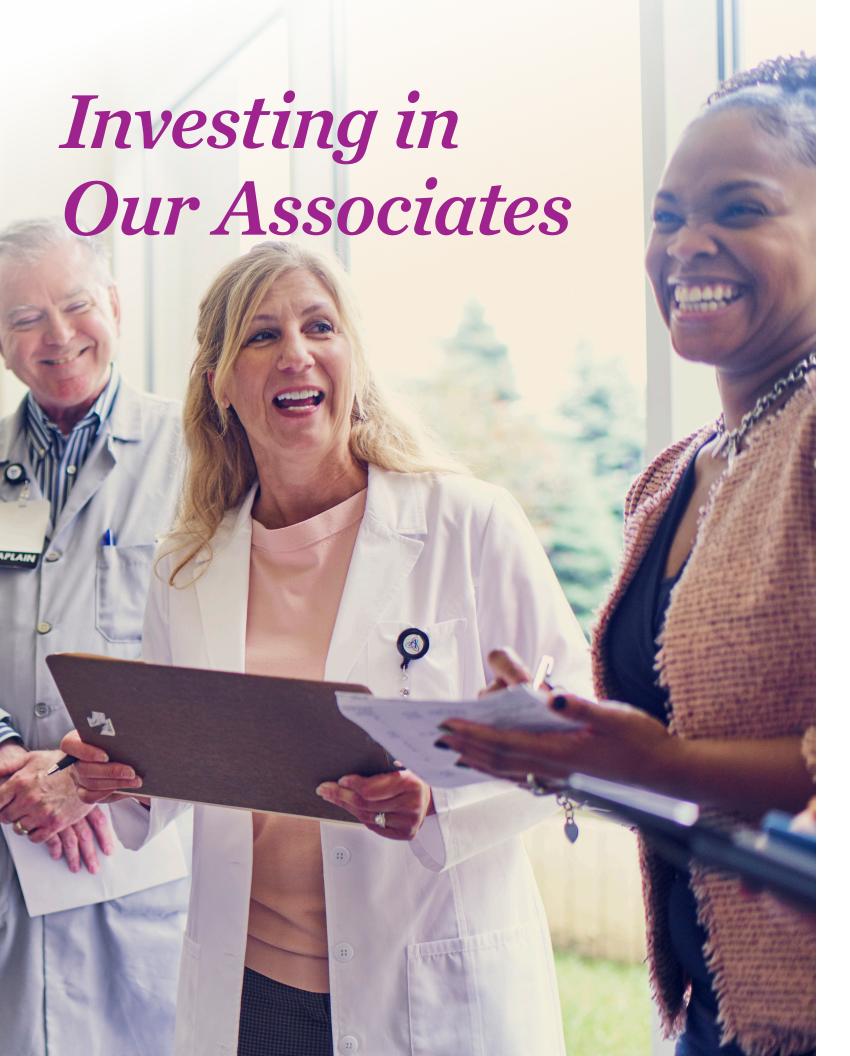
Associates volunteered with Project Linus to create blankets for children in need. These no-sew blankets will be distributed throughout Wilson County, providing comfort to children in hospitals, shelters and social services.

Meals for cancer patients

We partnered with The Heimerdinger Foundation, a truly unique nonprofit organization that provides nutrient-dense meals and nutrition education to individuals facing cancer through their Meals 4 Health and Healing program. Our volunteers came together to help create garden beds and plant the first batch of vegetables in their new food garden. This garden will ensure they have fresh, organic produce available for their meals, helping to nourish and support those who need it most.

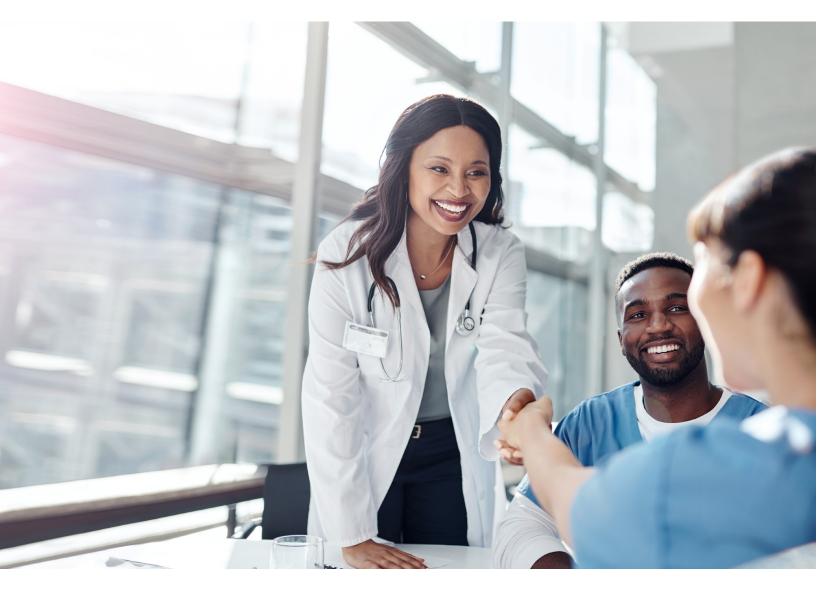


ATTRACT AND PREPARE

Onboarding experience

Over the past year, Ascension completed a comprehensive review of the onboarding experience, incorporating internal insights and external data to shape our improvement strategy.

Our efforts also encompass reducing duplication and simplifying forms to create a smoother onboarding journey that enhances efficiency and allows new associates to enter our organization with ease. myCare

Associates turn to myCare, Ascension's internal well-being site, for on-demand access to tools, videos and live support. The platform focuses on six key well-being categories: relational, occupational, financial, mental, spiritual and physical health, helping associates prioritize their overall well-being.

Well-being sessions

Associates can participate in live and recorded educational wellbeing sessions on topics such as healthy eating, ergonomics, behavior change, stress management, fitness and meditation, designed to instill healthy habits.

Spiritual direction

We provide virtual spiritual care by partnering associates with a licensed spiritual director to address spiritual and emotional needs, offering confidential support to navigate burnout, discern vocations and handle life transitions.

Provider Associate Care Team

The Provider Associate Care Team (PACT) connects associates experiencing distress from work-related events with trained volunteer peer supporters, offering a safe and confidential space to share emotions and concerns.

Socially Just Benefits approach

Designed with fairness and inclusivity in mind, this approach offers comprehensive coverage that addresses associates' physical, mental and financial well-being. The Health Benefits Subsidy provides financial waivers to eligible associates, covering costs for medical, pharmacy, dental, vision plans and more, ensuring that care remains affordable and accessible to all, regardless of their financial situation or life circumstances.

The Center for Career Advancement offers career services, training and educational programs designed to develop a skilled workforce within the communities we serve, with a focus on reaching and empowering marginalized groups.

Our "people-first" approach to career development includes efforts like short-term training programs, facility tours, job shadowing days, associate support, mentorship programs and high school summer camps.

Internal mobility and career pathways -

We want to ensure our associates have a clear understanding of the many possibilities within their career journeys. More importantly, we aim to equip them with the knowledge to confidently map those journeys, making the pathways to education and economic success more accessible.

To simplify the process of choosing a career path or growth opportunity, we conducted an in-depth assessment of workforce development programs across our markets. This resulted in approximately 100 career paths for internal associates. These pathways are designed to provide clear, accessible routes for growth and development, helping associates navigate opportunities as they advance at Ascension Saint Thomas.

CAREER PATHWAYS

We identified 100+ career paths for our associates

Clinical career paths: Clinical care, nursing, pharmacy services, clinical and patient support services, patient administrative services and providers.

Non-clinical career paths: Administrative services, business operations, business strategy development, charitable and community services, finance, human resources, information technology, marketing and communications, revenue cycle, supply chain and risk, quality and safety.

To ensure our associates have all the information they need about potential career paths, we used the information from our assessment to develop a visual mapping tool that highlights common career progression routes. The tool outlines advancement opportunities and provides key details such as role overviews, typical responsibilities and necessary credentials or education. It also helps associates identify transferable skills and areas where additional development, certifications or experience may be required.





Specialized training and support programs -

Ascension Saint Thomas is committed to providing associates with the resources and support needed to advance their careers through specialized training and educational opportunities.

These programs are designed to remove financial barriers, enhance clinical skills and create clear pathways for career growth, ensuring our workforce remains strong and prepared for the future of healthcare. Some of these opportunities include:

LPN Training Program: A pilot program at Ascension Saint Thomas Rutherford with 10 associates, focusing on a pathway from patient care technician (PCT) to licensed practical nurse (LPN). In partnership with TCAT Murfreesboro, Ascension Saint Thomas covers full tuition and books.

Participants retain full-time benefits

While working a flexible, reduced part-time schedule

LPN to RN Program: Provides qualified LPN associates the opportunity to attain their RN degree tuition-free. This program expands the nursing talent pipeline by onboarding LPNs with an option to become an RN within a specified period.

100% financial support included

Covering tuition, fees, books and NCLEX expenses

Nursing Corps: Financial support for Ascension Saint Thomas associates actively enrolled in nursing school who are also veterans or currently serving in the Army National Guard or Army Reserve forces.

First Assistant Training Program: Provides financial support for qualified associates to enhance their clinical skills and transition from a surgical technologist to a certified surgical first assistant.

Ascension Saint Thomas Foundations Scholarship Program: Scholarships awarded to associates pursuing associate's, bachelor's, and advanced degrees in fields like nursing, business administration, communications, imaging and radiology.

164 associates received scholarships

Program and participant spotlights

Vocare education program

We understand that a career is not just a series of jobs but a journey of continuous learning, making it essential to support our associates' growth and economic success.

Derived from the Latin word for 'to call,' Vocare is about more than just education — it empowers individuals to pursue their passion and calling in healthcare. Clinical pathways include surgical technology, pharmacy technician and medical assistant. With tuition paid directly to academic institutions, associates incur no out-of-pocket costs.

Surgical Technology (SurgTech): A free, self-paced certification program in partnership with the University of Memphis. The 15-month program helps fill critical certified roles like surgical technology by upskilling noncertified associates.

Pharmacy Technician (PharmTech): A structured training program designed to provide certification in pharmacy support roles.



Q & A with Ascension Saint Thomas associate: Deilani

Describe your career journey.

I have been with Ascension Saint Thomas for three years. I started as the administrative assistant to the Directors of Surgical Services, while I completed the CCMA Pathways Program through Ascension Saint Thomas and obtained my certification as a clinical medical assistant. I moved up to the surgical scheduler role for the Preoperative Medicine Clinic, and I am now a medical assistant for the Preoperative Medicine Clinic while being enrolled in the Vocare Education Programs Certified Surgical Technologist Program through the University of Memphis.

What resources has Ascension Saint Thomas provided that helped your career development?

Leadership support has been one of the biggest motivating sources in my career. They've supported me in everything I have set my heart's desire to do. Even when I didn't believe in myself, they never stopped believing in me and pushing me to my fullest potential. When I expressed my interest in possibly seeking a career path in surgery, they gave me full access to sit in and watch different surgical procedures to have the exposure and knowledge of the OR and the roles. From day one, I was never treated as just a behind-the-desk assistant. They [helped] me to be so much more involved.

Growing the healthcare workforce -

The healthcare landscape is constantly evolving, driven by advancements in technology, shifts in patient demographics and new care models.

As a result, Ascension Saint Thomas is continuously assessing both current and future workforce needs and addressing potential gaps. This proactive approach allows us to adapt to emerging trends, such as the increasing demand for specialized care, the integration of digital health tools and the need for culturally competent care.

Our workforce development efforts are essential to meeting the healthcare demands of our communities. One of the ways we do this is by building strong relationships with students through academic affiliation agreements across all our markets. We are implementing intentional, focused efforts to prepare future healthcare professionals and build a workforce that mirrors the diversity of our communities. This inclusive approach brings diverse perspectives to patient care, ultimately enhancing the quality of interactions and outcomes for those we serve.

Early career exposure and workforce development

The Ascension Saint Thomas Work-Based Learning Program offers high school seniors the opportunity to earn class credit, gain hands-on clinical skills and explore future careers in healthcare. The goal of the year-long pilot program is to build positive relationships with K-12 school systems, increase early career talent exposure to diverse healthcare roles and create a talent pipeline for entry-level positions in high-demand areas.

Fifty-two students from across five school districts work at Ascension Saint Thomas facilities, performing tasks such as patient transfers, specimen transport, basic patient care under supervision and career shadowing. They are paid hourly and earn academic credit, preparing them for higher education or immediate employment within Ascension Saint Thomas.

The Saint Thomas Scholars Program offers high school seniors medical assistant training. A mentor co-teaches with a health science teacher the MA certification curriculum to select seniors at seven local high schools. Since the mentor has a clinical background, they are able to help teach the skills portion and bring to life the material from real-world experience. Every April, the students sit for the CCMA exam through NHA.

Nursing Intern and Nurse Residency Program

We hire nursing students while they are still in school, providing them with the opportunity to work as nursing interns at Ascension Saint Thomas. This program not only helps build our nursing pipeline, but also allows students to gain hands-on experience. Interns work flexible schedules in an acute care unit and receive paid shadow experiences in the specialty units of their choice. Upon graduation and licensure, interns are given an opportunity to transition into our Nurse Residency Program.

The year-long Nurse Residency Program supports newly licensed registered nurses as they transition into practice. The program offers opportunities in various specialties, including acute care, cardiac, stepdown, ICU, ED, women's health and the operating room. It is designed to ensure ongoing growth and development as they become fully integrated into our team.

Ascension Saint Thomas opens center for nurses

Opened in September 2024 in partnership with Marian University's Leighton School for Nursing and Trevecca Nazarene University School of Nursing, this state-of-the-art nursing education center features innovative high-fidelity simulation mannequins, a 60-seat computer lab, four simulation labs with debrief rooms and three classrooms.

Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) Pathway Program —

This 15-week self-directed study program with six in-person events includes a simulation environment and skills check-off. After completion of the program, the graduates participate in a two-week paid clinical internship.
